INTRO

A lot of our students have grown up in the church and heard teachers and leaders talk about God, the Bible, Jesus and have heard words like salvation, crucifixion, or grace. We are gonna be going back over some of these topics and ideas and making sure that students understand them.

SCRIPTURE

- **Romans 3:23** - *for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,*
- **Romans 6:23** - *For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in[a] Christ Jesus our Lord.*
- **Romans 5:8** - *But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*
- **Romans 10:9** - *If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*
- **Romans 5:1** - *Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we[a] have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,*
