INTRO

A lot of our students have grown up in the church and heard teachers and leaders talk about God, the Bible, Jesus and have heard words like salvation, crucifixion, or grace. We are gonna be going back over some of these topics and ideas and making sure that students understand them.

The first week we talked about God, and His characteristics. The second week we are going to look at what the Bible is. The third week it was sin and this week we are going to talk about salvation!

SCRIPTURE

- **Acts 4:12** - *Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."*
- **1 Thessalonians 5:9** - *For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.*
- **Romans 8:5, 8** - *Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.*
- **Romans 1:16** - *I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.*
- **John 14:6** - *Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.*

• **Ephesians 2:8** - *For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—*

• **1 John 1:9** - *If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.*
